The Tattoo performance may take place on either Day 5 or Day 6 of your itinerary depending upon the day of the week on which you will be in Edinburgh.

*Please note that if you opt to join the "Train Journey from London to York with Locally Guided City Tour" option, your time in King's Cross Station and on the train is unescorted. A local representative will assist you with transferring from your hotel to Kings Cross Station in London, but you will navigate the station independently and will not meet up with a guide until you arrive at York Railway Station.


